Author/s' name/s' should be followed by their institutional affiliations and email ID of the presenting author. Avoid professional degrees. The abstract should be structured under following headings.
Original articles: Introduction, Objectives, Materials and Methods, Results, Conclusion.
Case Reports: Introduction, Case Details, Discussion

About HBTMC

Dr R.N. Cooper Hospital started as a Maternity Home in 1969. Since 1977, it was recognized as a teaching hospital, affiliated to KEM Hospital Trauma Unit, ICU & ICCU in a separate casualty building with Central Ambulance Service started in 1982. It was upgraded to General Hospital in 1970. The old hospital building became dilapidated in 1997 & Department of Gyn. & Obst. was shifted to Oshiwara Maternity Home.

In 2006, MCGM decided to redevelop it. Accordingly, redevelopment work was started in 2009. DR. R. N. Cooper Hospital was redeveloped & commissioned on 30th Nov 2013, with increased bed strength from 520 to 580 beds as a General Specialty Hospital providing secondary health care services in the Westerns Suburbs of MCGM. The hospital was affiliated with H. B. T. Medical College for annual intake of 150 UG medical students from July 2015, further increased to 200 UG students in 2019 by NMC resolution.

It has in the short span of time established multiple Superspeciality OPD's and is the only centre in the Western suburbs to have disability OPD. Despite being the youngest college, it has not lagged and is slowly and surely catching up and surging ahead.

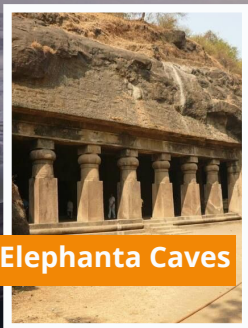

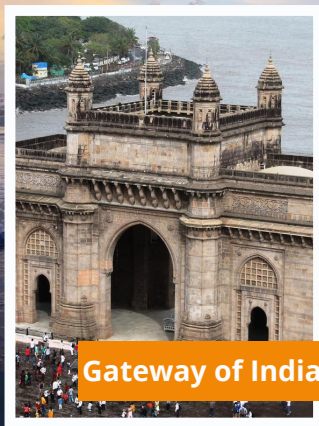
Welcome to the City of Dreams

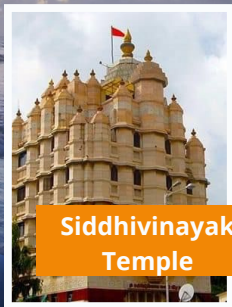
